Creative Aging Online Workshops

SilverKite® offers online arts workshops for all ages twice a week in a variety of art forms such as dance, painting, collage, creative writing, and more.

Online workshops are offered four times per month on alternating **Mondays at 1:30pm PT** and **Saturdays at 10:30am PT**. Partners can purchase a license to access some or all of our online workshops at \$200 per session plus local sales tax.



Online workshop partners receive a personalized webpage which includes registration links and recordings of the workshops. At the end of the month registration numbers for all of the licensed workshops are sent to the partner community.

SilverKite online arts workshops partners have included: Merrill Gardens, King County Library System, Sno-Isle Library System, and Jefferson County Library District.

Intergenerational School Program Model Descriptions

Arts Workshop Series

Pairs students with older adults to explore the curriculum through creative collaborative activities such as visual art projects, crafting, games, improvisational theatre exercises, and more.

Writing Life Stories: Memory Box Program

Students will interview residents and, from the stories shared, will design Memory Boxes in honor of their partner's life stories to gift to them at the Memory Box Ceremony

Community Service Coalitions

Students and older adults collaborate to identify, design, and implement need-based projects in their community.

Performance Ensembles: (Music, Choir, Theatre and Dance)

Music-making and music history ensembles, choirs, scripted performances and reader's theatre projects, interactive storytelling style events featuring audience participation and group play, and devised storytelling performance ensembles.

Customized Programs

Custom programs, such as language-learning programs, community art murals, museum exhibitions, and more, are developed around the needs and interests of your community.
